

**SANDOVAL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
COMMISSION CHAMBERS
MAY 16, 2013 – 6 P.M.**

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:05p.m.

Present were Chair Madalena, Vice Chair Scherzinger, Commissioner Lucero, Commissioner Chapman and Commissioner Walters.

Pledge of allegiance was led by Rio Rancho Police Officer Justin Garcia.

Chair Madalena announced the presentation by Pueblo of Santa Ana was rescheduled for the next meeting on June 6, 2013. Also the Pueblo of Jemez has a new designation, the San Jose de los Jemez Mission and Giusewa has been designated a National Historic Landmark.
