Action Requested: Motion to Approve Dispatch Services Agreement between Sandoval County and Sandia Tribal Police Department for Dispatch Services / \$150,592.18

Summary: Sandoval County contracts with the City of Rio Rancho for dispatch services. Sandia Pueblo Police Department is part of a Joint Powers Agreement with Sandoval County for dispatch services. This agreement will continue the dispatch services for the Sandia Tribal Police Department until July 1, 2014.

**PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS/EMERGENCY
DISPATCHING SERVICES**

**AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE COUNTY OF SANDOVAL
AND
THE SANDIA TRIBAL POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the County of Sandoval has a consolidated comprehensive Enhanced 911 Communication Center, Sandoval County Regional Emergency Communications Center (SCRECC) located at the Rio Rancho Department of Public Safety building in Rio Rancho, NM, and;

WHEREAS, this Center is capable of providing the necessary public safety communications and emergency dispatch service needs of the Pueblo of Sandia, and;

WHEREAS, the Sandia Tribal Police Department is in need public safety communications and emergency dispatch services for the Pueblo of Sandia, and;

WHEREAS, the cost to provide public safety communications and emergency dispatching and maintain the County's radio communication system continues to increase annually, and;

WHEREAS, Sandoval County has partially subsidized the cost of public safety communications and emergency dispatching services since the time of the Sandoval County 911 Communication's consolidation, and;

WHEREAS, the actual cost for public safety communications and emergency dispatching services for the Pueblo of Sandia for FY 2013-2014 based on calendar year 2012 utilization is \$150,592.18 and;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

SCOPE OF SERVICES;

Sandoval County will provide to the Sandia Tribal Police Department, full public safety and emergency dispatch services, which includes, but is not limited to:

Enhanced 911 Access	NCIC/NMCIC Access	Full County Radio System Access
Emergency Resources Access	Incident Logging	Telephone/Radio Recording

COMPENSATION: Sandia Tribal Police Department agrees to pay the County One Hundred Fifty Thousand Five Hundred Ninety Two and 18/100 dollars (\$150,592.18), and payable in full or in equal quarterly installments of Thirty Seven Thousand Six Hundred Forty Eight and 45/100 Dollars (\$37,648.045), on September 1, 2013; December 1, 2013; March 1, 2014; and June 1, 2014.

TERMINATION, This agreement may be terminated by either of the parties hereto upon written notice delivered to the other party at least thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of termination. By such termination neither party may nullify obligations already incurred for performance or failure to perform to the date of termination.

TERM OF CONTRACT: This Agreement is effective July 1, 2013 and will expire on June 30, 2014.

CONTRACT FOR SERVICES


This contract is immediately in effect and shall be in effect until mutually canceled in writing by both parties.
