2. Conclude Canvass of Results of the Primary Election of June 3, 2014


County Clerk Eileen Garbagni thanked Director Gutierrez and his staff for making this election a success. Director Gutierrez recognized his staff and also thanked the Administration staff for their help. Director Gutierrez presented the results of the Primary Election of June 3, 2014. Chairman Madalena asked why precinct 15 had several provisional ballots. Director Gutierrez explained that because of the precinct split, many voters were accustomed to voting in precinct 15 and should have now voted at precinct 77. These voters were allowed to vote provisional. Commissioner Scherzinger asked if the General Election in November will go as smoothly. Director Gutierrez anticipates another successful election in November 2014. Chairman Madalena asked how early a VCC location can be changed. Attorney Trujillo and Director Gutierrez explained that the change can take place any time after the primary election but needs to be done 4 months before the general election or a court order would be needed.




3. Adjourn


