

**SANDOVAL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
COMMISSION CHAMBERS
JULY 10, 2014 – 6 P.M.**

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Madalena called meeting to order at 6:26 p.m. Present were Vice Chairman Lucero, Commissioner Chapman and Commissioner Walters. Commissioner Scherzinger was absent.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Pledge of allegiance was led by Santa Fe County Treasurer Patrick Varela.

3. INTRODUCTIONS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

Treasurer Montoya announced the 38th wedding anniversary of her parents Mr. and Mrs. Montoya. Vice Chairman Lucero introduced County Commissioner District 1 candidate James Dominguez.
