**REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 5-17-12.9A
(AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A JUVENILE JUSTICE BOARD
AND PROVIDING FOR THE OPERATION OF THE BOARD)**

WHEREAS, Sandoval County created a Juvenile Justice Board in 2010 through adoption of Sandoval County Ordinance No. 10-1-21.8A; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 10-1-21.8A was replaced in 2012 with the adoption of Ordinance No. 5-17-12.9A; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to operate the Juvenile Justice Program through the passage of a resolution setting out the duties and responsibilities of the Juvenile Justice Board; and

WHEREAS, to avoid confusion Ordinance No. 5-17-12.9A should be repealed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Sandoval County Board of County Commissioners that Ordinance No. 5-17-12.9A is hereby repealed.
