Dear Mr. Rios,

I am writing to request a surplus road grader that you may be passing onto a deserving community in the county in the near future. As you know we have a road situation that is still in need of attention and it impacts safe travel for the communities of Cochiti, Sile, Santo Domingo and the surrounding villages in the area. While Cochiti now has design money for a bridge to replace the pulled culverts at the SP 85 crossing just south of our village, it will be months, perhaps a couple of years before we have the bridge constructed. In the mean time, we need to keep the crossing safe for school buses, emergency vehicles, and other users of SP 85. Our own grader will do just the job for frequent attention to that troublesome detour. We have gotten commitment for an operator from BLM and fuel from another agency.

Please consider our request as this piece of equipment will serve more than just our community. Sile still gets land locked even with the repairs that have been made on the Santo Domingo side of their village and there is good reason to think the matter will not be resolved until we get a bridge.
