A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION, LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION, TO PARTICIPATE IN THE JUVENILE ADJUDICATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Legislature enacted Section 34-16-1 NMSA 1978 establishing a juvenile adjudication fund grant program to fund programs providing alternative procedures of adjudication for juveniles charged with traffic offenses and other misdemeanors; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature enacted Section 66-8-116.3 NMSA 1978 as amended, creating the juvenile adjudication fund by assessing fees levied and collected; and

WHEREAS, the County, along with participating agencies, is making application to the Department of Finance and Administration, Local Government Division, for supplemental program funding.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Sandoval County, State of New Mexico, hereby authorizes the submission of the FY16 application for the Juvenile Adjudication Fund under the regulations established by the Local Government Division.

Proposal Information

Project Summary (Please give 2-3 sentence summary of request):

Sandoval County is requesting funding to support the Cuba Independent Schools Learning Lab, Bernalillo Public Schools Learning Lab and the Reception & Assessment Centers (RAC) at both of these schools. The RAC Centers accept and provide services for at-risk youth. The goal of the RAC centers is to intervene swiftly and connect youth and their family to community resources to prevent involvement with the juvenile justice system. The RAC Centers provide an intake interview, needs assessment, crisis intervention, case management and transition to local services for at-risk youth. The Learning Labs serves as a safe alternative to out-of-school suspension where students will have behavior assessments conducted at the RAC Center which will delve deeper into why the student struggles academically and "acts out" in an educational environment. The Learning Labs and RAC Centers address the underlying issues of substance abuse prevention, truancy, anger management, counseling, tutoring, parental involvement, and credit recovery. This Alternative Adjudication Program provides alternative procedures for juveniles charged with misdemeanors or for those at-risk of being involved in the juvenile justice system.
