Ms. Trujillo,

The San Antonio de las Huertas Land Grant (SADLHLG) is a subsidy of the State of New Mexico. We answer to the NM Land Grant Council, who is an appointed board by the Governor, because of our governmental status we work closely with the Congressional Committee, especially Congresswoman Grishim's office and Congressman Udall's office. We have meetings every other month with Congresswoman Grishim, multiple monthly meetings with the Forestry Department. We are a Cooperative Agency for the Forestry Department and are currently working with ten other Cooperative Agencies creating a plan for the West side of the Sandia Mountains. We also work closely with the Mayor's Office in Bernalillo and have multiple meetings each month with the State of NM. We meet monthly with the Land Grant Consejo which is an organization of 25 Land Grants in the State of NM. We oversee the Las Placitas Water Board, manage two cemeteries and own multiple roads in Placitas. We currently have an MOU with the County concerning storage of equipment and supplies.

Due to the amount of traveling we do as a subsidy of the State of NM a vehicle is vitally important. Currently, we are using our personal vehicles to transport us to governmental meetings and the SADLHLG reimburses us the travel expenses. By owning a vehicle this would eliminate the need for reimbursement and in the long run will save money for the Land Grant.
